### Free School Meal - Pupil Premium

Just a reminder that although all children in the Infants are entitled to a free school meal, parents can still apply for 'free school meals' pupil premium. This is different to and should not be confused with, the daily free meal that all infant children are entitled to. Applying is really straightforward and Miss Edwards in the school office is more than happy to provide more information or a form to complete if you think that you might be eligible. A successful application means that school secures additional funding which is used to fund extra-curricular activities for your child, trips and visits, snack and Toast Club and additional support and resources.
