The children have all returned and launched straight into new units of work. We had a special delivery to Nursery on Tuesday with the arrival of our duck eggs. Things were clearly far too exciting in Nursery as by the afternoon one duckling had already hatched, and another was on the way. Reception started their week making and tasting some delicious smoothies during a Sefton Healthy Habits workshop. Yr1 have been getting ready for their Phonics Screener checks next week, playing lots of phonic games this week to help them recap and retrieve their knowledge. Year 2 have also been preparing for their end of key stage assessments, which will be taking place over the next 2 weeks. They have also started thinking about transition to Forefield Junior School and have even started learning some songs for their incredible leavers production.

Forest School sessions will resume next week for Nursery, Reception and Year 1. Year 2 will not take part in Forest School sessions this half term, due to transition activities and leavers production preparation, there just isn't enough hours in the week. Instead, they will have a longer afternoon session at the end of the term, doing all of the parts of Forest School they enjoy most.

Next week we will start our transition activities with Year 2 children. We will begin with an assembly on Monday, sharing how classes are mixed up when children move to Yr3.
